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Organising team EBEC Zagreb

EBEC

STEP 01

EBEC is a team — based competition in 2 categories — Team Design and Case Study. Both categories are based on interdisciplinary tasks developed for students of technology. Each student that comes from a technical university where a Local BEST Group is operating has the right to take part in EBEC.

STEP 02

The students participating in EBEC are divided into teams of four. These teams choose to compete in one of the two categories: Innovative Design or Case Study. The teams taking part in the Innovative Design category have limited time to come up with new and innovative solution of already existing or completely new proses or product. The solution should have technical, social, environmental, and economic impact. Participants in the Case Study category work on an intensive analysis of a technology problem and come up with detailed suggestions for a solution to the given problem.

STEP 03

EBEC is organized and coordinated by students that are members of Local BEST Groups around Europe. After the Local round, winners are participating in regional round in Maribor and have a chance to compete further on EBEC Final in Zagreb! BEST (Board of European Students of Technology) is a non-profit, apolitical student organisation that strives to provide high-quality services to students by bringing closer the stakeholders from "students — universities — companies" triangle.

Important info



Regional round of EBEC Zagreb will be held on 12th of March. Location is Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing.



Communication with the organizers before the event can be accomplished true ezdi@best.hr mail, direct contact of organizers and social networks. During competition teams will be divided in lodge/boxes to ensure privacy and epidemiological distance.



You will be competing in teams of 4 members. Each team should have their team name and all the members should have internet connection, otherwise they will not be able to do research for a given topic.



During the day of selected topic - Innovative Design or Case Study - all team members need to be present during task research time and task presentation.

Innovative Design

STEP 01 You and your team will have 8 hours to solve the challenges presented by the BEST Topic representative. The whole team combines their creativity and knowledge to develop new technological designs or improve upon existing ones. Their professional presentation should demonstrate the technical, social, environmental, and economic impact of their design. The goal is not to produce a working device in a limited time, but to show that you are able to create something out of the box to address one need of society not solved yet or improve existing one.

The second challenge: presentation of the solution is also the real-life challenge that students will face when they will pitch their ideas in front of potential investors or funders. It is crucial for them to concisely deliver a convincing message. The prototype (if made) does not need to be fully functional, but rather to illustrate the idea of the future implementation. It can be mechanical, a mockup with modelling software, a minimum viable product, the part of the final product to test something specific, etc. All solutions and ideas after EBEC are teams intellectual property.

You will need a laptop per table with the capability of connecting to the internet.
